OBJECTIVES OF THE COP NTFPs

Provide a platform for sharing of knowledge, resources and best practices amongst African forestry stakeholders, with focus on NTFPs and how they can contribute to livelihood and climate resilience.

Specifically, the platform aims to discuss challenges, opportunities, share best practices and useful resources for supporting development of the value chains of:

- NTFPs that are of nutritional, medicinal and cosmetic significance in general with particular focus on gums and resins;
- NTFPs of wood products (e.g., firewood, charcoal, wood carvings, etc.).



COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE – THE APPROACH

- □ First three days of each week: a zoom meeting will be held starting with a short introductory presentation of about 20 minutes followed by discussion / experience sharing among participants
- □ Remaining 2 days of each week, participants will continue sharing experiences through an ediscussion platform. These interactive sessions will be scheduled for between 1 – 3 hours per day
- On the e-discussion platform, participants will be able to view daily summaries, discussion threads and access resources at any time during the three-week period that the platform is live.

Last day of 3rd week will also be on *Zoom* – recap of the 3 weeks
